Speaking passionately about teaching people what sourdough bread is, seed sticks and baguettes, Clare offers some interesting tips on working with bread.

You’ve had some bread for a while and you are wondering what to do with it, take that stale bread, bake it in the oven for a bit and then toss it into your salads. The bread soaks up all the juices of the salad making for a quick, delicious offering.

Another option is to slice up a loaf of bread and then drizzle olive oil, put some herbs and some cheese in there and pop it into the oven. Everything melts nicely together and you serve and enjoy it as pull-apart bread.

An electrical engineer by profession, Hans van Hooreweghe had not anticipated that his journey to the Democratic Republic of Congo at the age of 25 to run a tea factory, would entice the idea of bringing a piece of his Belgian roots to neighboring Zimbabwe. During a trip to Zimbabwe to explore investment opportunities, he noticed a gap in the food market, specifically chocolate. Belgian chocolate would form an original idea, the perfect business opportunity to bring into Zimbabwe.

"If you make a cheap product you will not survive," says Hans. 20 years into the business, Veldemeers chocolate is definitely doing something right.

For the Veldemeers brand, quality is resolute.

*Only organic ingredients are used for Veldemeers chocolate and none of the chocolates include preservatives.

*The raw materials for Veldemeers chocolate are imported from Belgium and the main ingredient couverture, a raw chocolate, is made in Belgium.

*The raw chocolate arrives on Zimbabwean soil in bulk as a semi-finished product, then melted and transformed into a finished product at the Veldemeers factory in Msasa.

*The only local ingredients used are sugar, butter, cream and macadamia nuts.

*For the amaretto chocolate, the amaretto is imported from Italy.

*Chocolates are stored at room temperature in Veldemeers shops and are kept for no longer than 2 weeks for quality control purposes.

FUN FACTS

- > Veldemeers lane is the street founder van Hooreweghe grew up in and this was the inspiration behind the name.
- > Veldemeers chocolate is an original Belgian recipe.
- > There are two types of Veldemeers chocolate, one made from a chocolate mold which always has the exact same shape and one that is a bit rougher made by using a filling and you roll that filling and cover it with chocolate.
- > The quickest Veldemeers chocolate takes about 30 minutes to make

The Gift That Keeps On Giving

Nothing radiates purpose more than a personalised touch. For Irene Verghis, this meant infusing her mother's Greek recipes into the Cafénion menu.

Cafénion
At Arundel Village since 2016



Growing up, watching her mother Ourana Mitchell cooking was the order of the day. "She was really my inspiration, most of my recipes are hers." Irene says of her mother adoringly. Cafénion, which means coffee shop in Greek is her own spin of how she's carried this tradition forward with her son Milton. Their Greek heritage and Zimbabwean roots influenced the eclectic Cafénion menu, an interplay between different dishes from sandwiches and hamburgers to Greek style wraps-gyros, short bread, spinach and cheese pies.

For Irene, who doubles up as a caterer for private events, being able to share recipes is something she sees as a gift. 'Tis the season for giving back and this Christmas season she shares her ekmek kataifi Greek dessert recipe (for 1 square):

For the base:

Crumble the kataifi dough into a buttered baking pan. Bake in moderate heat (180 degrees) until it's golden brown. Boil one cup of sugar and a cup of water for 3 minutes and pour this syrup onto the golden brown pastry.

On the side:

Beat egg yolks with sugar. Then add cornflour that has been dissolved in ½ packet of milk. Next, add vanilla. Heat 2-½ pints of milk in the microwave. Slowly add the hot milk to the egg mixture, stirring continuously. When it's all mixed up, put it in the microwave and cook on high until it's thick. Take it out of the microwave after 5 minutes and add 2 soup spoons of butter continuing to stir. After thickening, let it cool. Cover the kaitafi with the ¾ packet of whipped cream mixed with sugar and vanilla, sprinkle pistachio nuts.

For the base:

A third to ½ a packet of kataifi pastry dough
125 grams of fresh butter

For the syrup:

1 cup sugar
1 cup water

For the custard:

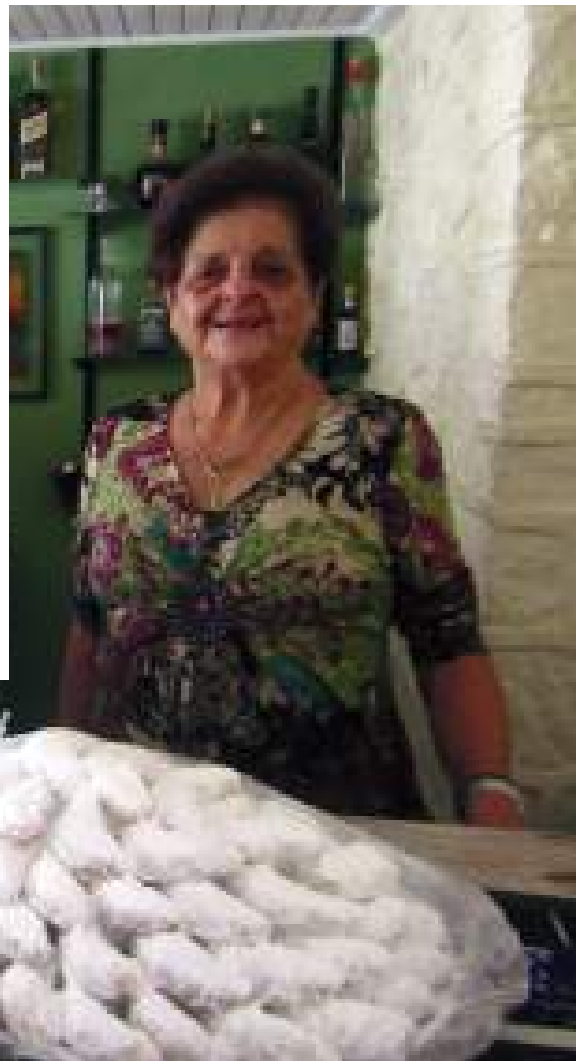
3 packets of milk
(keep ½ a packet to mix with cornflour)
¾ cup of sugar
2 tea spoons vanilla
1 cup cornflour
3 egg yolks
2 soup spoons of fresh butter

For the Whipped cream:

¾ packet of whipped cream
60 grams icing sugar
¼ tea spoon vanilla extract

Topping:

Pistachio nuts



Shin has sinew and connective tissue but this will melt away in the slow cooker. This does two things - it means that the beef literally falls apart once cooked, and it adds a gelatinous richness to your broth.

Slow Cooked Shin

A great dish for the Holidays - brought to you by Tudely Butchery

Tudely Butchery

INGREDIENTS (serves 4):

1kg beef shin, cut into large egg sized chunks
Half a bottle of red wine
500 ml beef stock
2 large onions - sliced
2-3 medium carrots - sliced into thick rings
8 cloves of garlic - peeled whole
2 sticks of celery - chopped finely
200g bacon bits
Bay leaf
Few sprigs of rosemary
Salt, Pepper
Olive oil, Butter for frying
1 tblspn tomato puree
Splash balsamic vinegar
Plain flour for dredging

Heat olive oil and butter in a large frying pan. Add bacon bits and fry for a few minutes. Set bacon aside once cooked but leave as much fat as possible in pan. Add crushed garlic to frying pan, alongside onions, celery and carrots. Fry for approx. 5 minutes until slightly softened. Add to slow cooker. Dredge beef in flour and shake to remove excess. Brown in

pan, a few chunks at a time. Brown for a few minutes only, it doesn't matter if the meat is not 'sealed'. Add to the slow cooker. Deglaze pan with a little red wine to lift any meat or remaining ingredients from pan. Add to slow cooker along with the remaining wine, stock, tomato purée, balsamic, bay leaf and rosemary. Ensure the beef is covered by the liquid.

Season with a little salt and pepper (not too much, the bacon will add a lot of saltiness to the stew anyway). Cook on HIGH for 1 hour and then turn to LOW for 7-8 hours. Add bacon bits to slow cooker approx. 2 hours before the end. Once cooked (the beef should fall apart with a gentle prod from a fork), drain the ingredients into a sieve over a large pan.

Heat the liquid in the pan on high for approx. 10 mins to thicken. Optional - use a flour or cornflour to thicken gravy. Remove bay leaf and rosemary from meat mixture. Serve atop mashed potato or alongside some greens, pouring the thickened liquid over the beef.

Carrying popular perfume brands from Gucci, Estee Lauder to Christian Dior, the parlor price their fragrances around the 4-bottle sizes ranging from \$5 for a 5ml bottle to \$25 for a 30ml bottle, all oil-based Eau de Parfum.

Understanding this perfect balance meant understanding the science behind choosing a fragrance and how best to apply it for a lasting scent, from the choice between Eau de Parfum and Eau de Toilette and oil-based versus alcohol-based perfumes.

Three notes

All perfumes release three notes, the top which is the first scent, heart and base notes. The Eau de Parfum scent lasts longer. The top note is released first, followed by the heart note, which unfolds the scent over a longer period of time. With Eau de Toilette, the top notes released are dominant, making it initially very refreshing only to evaporate rather quickly.

Oil-based versus alcohol-based

An oil-based perfume not only moisturizes the skin, but also retains the scent for a longer period of time as they evaporate slower than alcohol-based perfumes.

Looking for that lasting scent?

Tracey recommends layering of the scent: When you step out of the shower or bath and your skin is cool, spray your favourite perfume into a handful of your body cream, mix it up and apply it onto your body. Next, take Vaseline and apply it onto your pulse points because these areas radiate heat (for instance behind your ears) spray your perfume on those areas for a lasting scent.

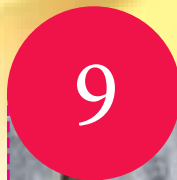
It is usually a horizontal evergreen wreath with four candles, sometimes with a fifth, white candle in the center.

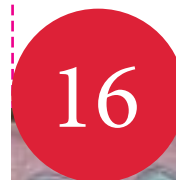

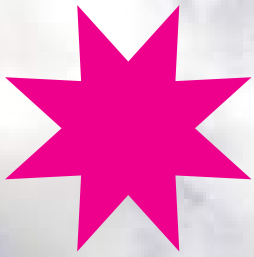

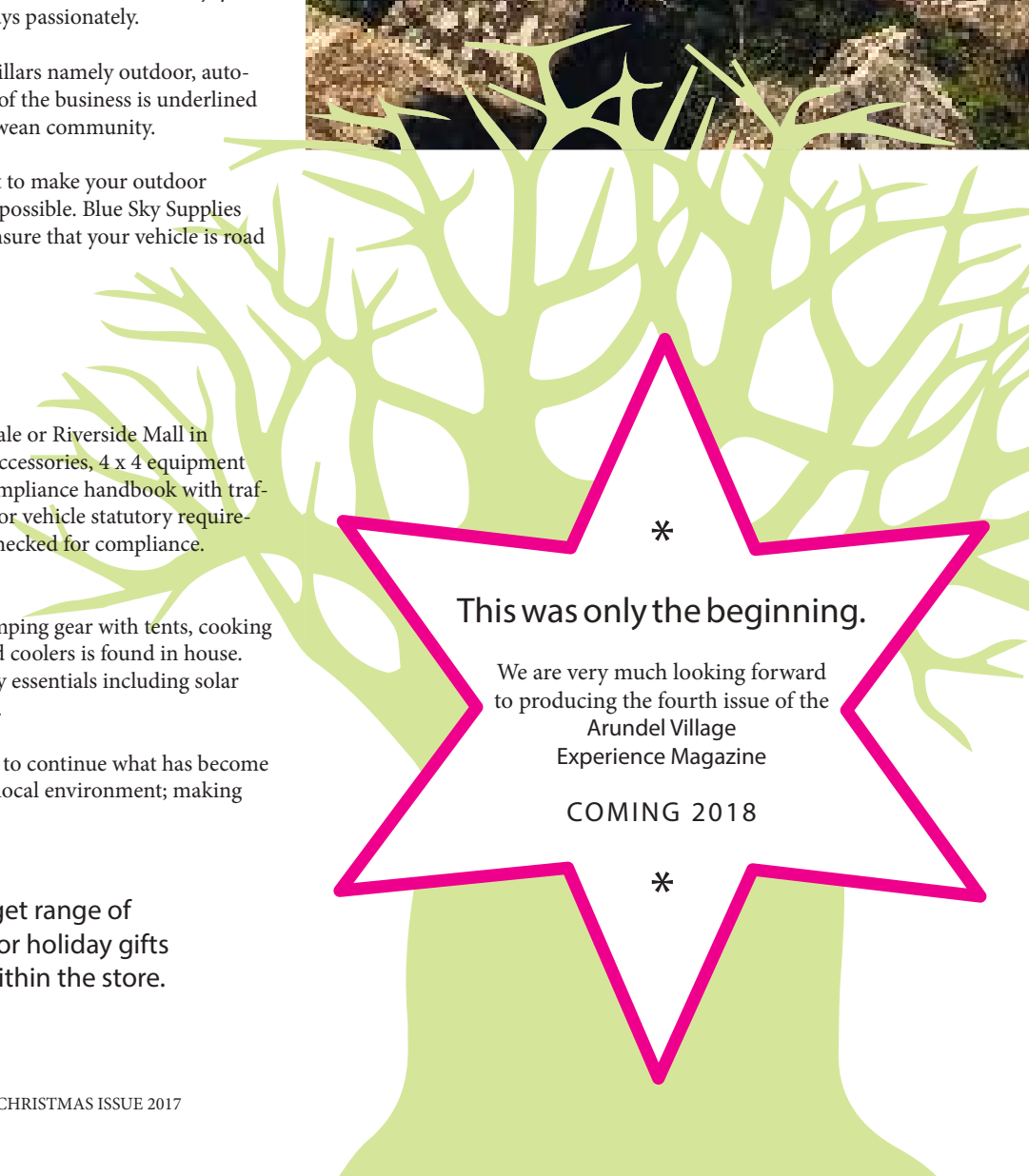
